Dear Sir,

Kindly refer to our letter dated 18th June, 2019 on the above subject explaining the difficulties being faced by the spouses of retired employees of Coal India Limited for settlement of family pensions in case of death of retired employees.

We would like to again inform you that, in the case of death of a retired employee / pension holder, the spouse is required to visit the place of last posting of the retired employee to initiate the process of claim of family pension. This system is causing a lot of difficulties to the surviving spouse, due to, largely having settled at a far off place after superannuation, and also due to ageing in many cases. It is brought to our notice that in a number of cases, the last place of posting of such retired employee is no longer in operation now and it is difficult to trace the required records.

We would like you to appreciate the issue and agree that any or every document for identification of the spouse is already available with CMPF Authority. Hence, there is an urgent need of simplifying the process and eliminate any need of visiting the last place of posting by the spouse for settlement of pension. Hence it is requested that the matter may be looked into for immediate redressal.
